## **Turkey Airmail**

#### Bill Robertson

Bill had a long time interest in Middle East philately, particularly in Turkish Airmails and Free French Censor markings during World War II. He published a book on these markings in 1989 and after further study and research, a revised version was published in 2012. His early Turkish Airmail material has attracted much attention and a few years ago he was invited to display a special exhibition in the Dolmabahçe Palace in Istanbul. He also exhibited competitively and won several international gold medals.

He was an enthusiastic member of his local society the Edinburgh Philatelic Society, the British Airmail Society and actively supported both The Association of Scottish Philatelic Societies and The Association of British Philatelic Societies. His main society interest, however, was The Oriental Philatelic Society of London (OPAL).

Over thirty years of membership he held most of the Society's offices, including President from 1997-2004. All material from Bill's collection in this catalogue has been annotated 'ex Collection Bill Robertson'.


